FOR FAMILIES: Supporting Students using myON and myON News

Dear Families,

As you may already know, our students are using myON at school to support their reading growth. The myON digital reading application provides access to thousands of digital books for independent reading practice.

Teachers may also incorporate books from myON within their lessons—and they may assign projects within the myON application that students can complete at school or at home.

Regardless of how your students are using myON in school, it is important also that they keep reading and learning at home.

Tips for families to support student learning at home

- Ask your student to show you their reading interests in myON.
- Ask your student to show you their Profile Report in myON and discuss how they see themselves as a reader.
- Sit with your student and read together (this is especially important for students in grades K–3).
- Use one of the science texts on myON to do an at-home experiment.
- Understand how your student’s teacher is monitoring progress to support student completion of work.
